This outreach is called ***The Light is On For You***, and is an effort on the part of our Diocese to highlight the importance of the sacrament of confession in the life of Catholics and to make it as easy as possible for every Catholic to come or to return to this great source of God's mercy and healing love. You are welcome to come here or to go to any other Catholic church. Did you know.....that last year CAFOD received £1,396.42 from the donation of old coins and foreign currencies? The unwanted coins from Lancaster Diocese amounted to £129.80 in value.
