UPDATE THE RE OPENING OF CHURCHES FOR PRIVATE PRAYER.

As from the 15th June places of worship have been given the green light to open for private prayer. National guidance has been sent out to all Dioceses on how this must be done safely. Our Bishop has disseminated the guidance with a list of requirements which parishes in Lancaster are expected to comply with. The teams at Holy Family and St Anne's are now reviewing the preparations made so far. These will then have to be approved by the Diocese before our churches can officially reopen. It's a bit more complicated than we envisaged - but that's life!

There is a requirement for Stewards/Ushers to supervise the comings and goings when our churches are open. The principal role of the usher is to ensure that social distancing is observed, and hygiene standards are maintained.

We need people to offer to be stewards/ushers who

- are known to the parish priest (possibly already signed up as volunteers for something else!)
- are not classed as vulnerable by current government guidance because of underlying health condition or age
- are not on a safeguarding plan
- are over 16 years old
