## **Feast Days**

- 22nd Aug Our Lady, Queen and Mother
- 24th Aug St BARTHOLOMEW, Apostle, feast
- 25th Aug St Louis or St Joseph of Calasanz
- 26th Aug Blessed Dominic of the Mother God (Dominic Barberi)
- 27th Aug St Monica
- 28th Aug St Augustine, Bishop, Doctor
- 29th Aug Beheading of St John the Baptist
- 31st Aug St Aiden, Bishop and Missionary, and the saints of Lindisfarne
- 3rd Sept: St Gregory the Great, Pope, Doctor. He sent St Augustine and his monks to England as missionaries in 596AD
- 4th Sept: St Cuthbert, secondary patron of the diocese. One of the monks of Lindisfarne, died 687AD whose remains were brought to Lytham to escape the Vikings.
- 5th Sept: St Herbert, friend of St Cuthbert, who lived as a hermit on an island in Derwent water.

Votive Candles: At the moment we cannot burn votive candles because of the risk of fire. We do have a sanctuary light on the sanctuary, which is lit all the time. If any of you would like to sponsor this sanctuary light which usually lasts for one week, please put an offering (suggest between 5 to 10 pounds sterling) in an envelope marked 'Sanctuary light' and put it in the collection box at the back of the Church. If you have an intention please include it on the envelope.
