Daily Prayer Cardinal Nichols has suggested a shared moment of national prayer at 6pm each day and for us to observe 21 November the Feast of Christ the King as a day of prayer for ending the pandemic.

Below is the statement from the Catholic Bishops' Conference. On Wednesday Parliament passed into law the Regulations governing many aspects of activity in the whole of England until Wednesday, 2 December.

"These Regulations prohibit the gathering of people for communal worship in churches and other religious buildings. Despite profound misgivings it is important that we, as responsible citizens, observe these Regulations, which have the force of law."

IICSA: On Tuesday 10 November the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse published its report on the Catholic Church, It makes sobering reading and has attracted national media attention. We pray for all those victims and survivors of abuse particularly those hurt by members of our church, and we ask forgiveness for the times the church has failed to listen and respond with compassion.
