Schedule for Holy Week 2021:

March 27th/28th Palm Sunday-Blessing of Palms at all Masses. No processions.

March 31st Service of Reconciliation 7pm St Anne's Westby
April 1st Holy Thursday: Mass of the Lord's Supper, followed by a short period of 'Watching' (till 10pm) at Holy Family. No washing of the feet and no procession.

April 2nd Good Friday: Solemn Liturgy of the Passion 3pm at Holy Family & St Anne's (Day of Fasting and Abstinence). No individual veneration of the cross.

April 3rd Holy Saturday: Vigil & First Mass of Easter 8pm at Holy Family. No fire & Paschal Candle lit in its place, with a shortened liturgy.

April 4th EASTER DAY Masses at 10am in Holy Family & St Anne's.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: With all the disruption of schools open and then not open I have come to the decision that we will have a First Holy Communion programme in the Autumn term starting in early September and the First Holy Communion will take place just before Christmas 2021.
