Day of Prayer for Victims and Survivors of Abuse:

Three years ago, the Pope asked each Bishops'
Conference to hold a 'Day of Prayer' for the victims and
survivors of sexual abuse. Initially, the Bishops'
Conference of England and Wales chose the Friday of the
Fifth Week of Lent. However, listening to the voices of
victims and survivors, the Bishops have moved this Day of
Prayer for Victims and Survivors of Abuse to the Tuesday
of the Fifth Week of Easter, which is the 4th May this year.
