Guidance for Communal Worship during the COVID-19

Pandemic – Step 4 Although most legal restrictions relating to the Covid pandemic are ending on Monday 19th July, a degree of caution is still needed to protect the vulnerable in the parish. A summary of guidance from the C.B.C.E.W is below. Full details can be found at

1. **Track and Trace:** although no longer legally required, it has been recommended that we continue to "check in" with the NHS QR code poster via the NHS COVID-19 app or on the 'logbook' as you enter church. To help identify outbreaks and alert attendees.
2. **Face coverings:** should still be worn by all those coming to a church service (exemptions for medical reasons excluded.).
3. **Social distancing** will not be mandatory in our churches; however larger churches might consider still keeping some social distancing in place.
4. **Hand sanitising** will remain necessary on arrival.
5. **Cleaning of benches:** not required between services; however, it will remain best practice to at least clean bench tops if there are two services on the same day.
6. **Holy Communion**
 - In the hand should be restored to its traditional place and with a Communion procession (trying to accommodate those who wish to social distance). Stewards will instruct benches row by row.
 - Communion on the tongue is permissible, and it should take place at the end of Communion, rather than after Mass, the priests must use sanitiser after each communicant has presented themselves.
 - Holy Communion under both kinds will not be re-introduced at this time.
7. **Singing** can be restored, however, C.B.C.E.W. recommends a phased re-introduction of singing. Hymn books/service books can be used once in a day.
8. **A Sign of Peace** involving contact with other persons should remain suspended.
