#### Memorial service to mark the 77<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the

**Freckleton air disaster:** Will take place beside the Children's Grave at Holy Trinity Church, Lytham Road, Freckleton, starting from 10.30am on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2021. Please note, although this service has been advertised for Sunday 22 August, it is now intended to hold the service only on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> Aug at 10.30am

**Candles:** We have recently been notified of fires involving St Killians candle burning systems. Although we aren't burning votive candles at the moment. We would like to ask parishioners to be aware and ensure any candles have been extinguished.

**Guidance for Communal Worship during the COVID-19 Pandemic – Step 4** Although most legal restrictions relating to the Covid pandemic are ending on Monday 19th July, a degree of caution is still needed to protect the vulnerable in the parish. **Track and Trace:** although no longer legally required, it has been strongly encouraged that we continue to "check in" with the NHS QR code poster via the NHS COVID-19 app or on the 'logbook' as you enter church.

**Face coverings:** should still be worn by all those coming to a church service (exemptions for medical reasons).

**Social distancing** will not be mandatory in our churches.

However larger churches might consider still keeping some social distancing in place.

**Hand sanitising** will remain necessary on arrival.

**Cleaning of benches:** not required unless two services held on the same day.

**Holy Communion :** In the hand should be restored to its traditional place and with a Communion procession (trying to accommodate those who wish to social distance). Stewards will instruct benches row by row. Holy Communion under both kinds will not be re-introduced at this time.
