Track and Trace: although no longer legally required, it has been strongly encouraged that we continue to "check in" with the NHS QR code poster via the NHS COVID-19 app or on the 'logbook' as you enter church.

Face coverings: should still be worn by all those coming to a church service (exemptions for medical reasons).

Social distancing will not be mandatory in our churches.

Hand sanitising will remain necessary on arrival.
