Cleator Pilgrimage: This year's pilgrimage to Our Lady's shrine at Cleator is on the 11th September. It will be led by Bishop Paul. The first church at Cleator opened in 1853 and the current church in 1872. The grotto was built by unemployed iron ore workers in 1927 in return for clothing and food vouchers. It was dedicated by Cardinal Hume in 1980.
