Shroud of Turin Exhibition - The Christian Heritage Centre
Monday 6th - Wednesday 22nd March 2023.

The original Shroud of Turin is rarely shown to the public. This exhibition offers visitors an important chance to engage with what is arguably the most enigmatic artefact known to man. Accompanying the replica will be a historical and scientific commentary, looking at both its authenticity and its importance for Christians. Booking is required.

Ash Wednesday: We begin the season of Lent by receiving blessed ashes as a sign of our desire to repent of our sins and prepare for the upcoming feast of Easter. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at both Masses on Wednesday. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence. Fasting refers to eating only one meal (with the possibility of two snacks) for those between 18 and 60. Abstinence is from meat for all those over 14.

Shrove Tuesday: the name of this day (often called Pancake Day, because pancakes use up all the things formerly forbidden during Lent) comes from the old English phrase for going to confession, to be shaven. In preparation for the season of Lent it would be good to consider going to confession this week.
