**Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence. All Catholics over the age of 14 are to abstain from meat. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 are to fast (that is only one full meal and up to two 'snacks').**

**Chrism Mass:** on Thursday the Bishop will celebrate the Chrism Mass at 11.30am in Lancaster Cathedral. He will bless the holy oils which will be used to administer the sacraments during the following year. Also at this Mass the priests renew their promises. All are welcome.

**Mass on Wednesday will be at 9.45am. It will be followed by a short re-enactment of the passion by the school children.**

**Collection for the Holy Places:** at the end of the Liturgy of the Passion on Good Friday afternoon there will be the annual collection to support the Christians in the holy land.

**Easter Duties:** A reminder that it is one of the precepts of the Church that all Catholics should go to confession and Holy Communion at least once a year around Easter. It is good practice to go to confession in preparation for Easter.
