The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the living sign of God's immense love for us.

Feast of Corpus Christi: 11th June. On this day the Church honours in a special way the mystery of the Body and Blood of Christ present for us in the Holy Eucharist. After the 10.45am Mass there will be Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, and weather permitting a short procession of the Blessed Sacrament around the grounds. The Church asks parishes to host such processions as a public witness to our faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Host.

NB Sunday 18th June Mass at 9.45am. We have had to alter the Mass time for this week because the half-marathon would block access to church at the normal Mass time. Apologies for any inconvenience caused.

Confirmations: The Bishop will be coming on Monday 20th November at 6.30pm to celebrate the sacrament of confirmation. This important sacrament is the completion of our baptism and important source of grace for living the christian life. Any child or adult over the age of 10 who has not yet been confirmed is eligible to receive this sacrament this November in our parish.
