How the altar will be consecrated (Part 1): Before we can use our new altar for the celebration of Mass or for prayer it must be consecrated, dedicated to the service of God alone. In a recognition of the importance of the Mass, and the space it is celebrated in, the Church reserves her altars solely for prayer and sacrifice to God. Therefore until the Bishop comes on 17th September we will not use the new altar (even after it has been installed), waiting for this solemn moment to give it to God. In the Old Testament God provided the Jews with rules about how they were to construct altars for His worship and how they were to be consecrated. While as Christians, in emergency our worship can be celebrated anywhere, we recognise that it helps us understand the sacredness of these acts by setting aside sacred spaces for them. Many of the rites for the consecration of a new altar draw on these rites God laid down in the Old Testament interpreted in the light of Christ. The Church asks that, in preparation for the dedication of an altar, the faithful are instructed on the meaning of these rites. Over the next few weeks I will explain them in the newsletter.
