**Thursday 29th June is the Feast of Ss Peter and Paul. It is a holyday of obligation. Masses are Wednesday 28th 7pm (Vigil - Holy Family), Thursday 29th 9.45am (Holy Family) 7pm (Westby)**

**Freckleton Club Day.** A big thank you to all those who walked in Club Day last weekend and represented our Church in this procession of witness, together with all those who helped in the preparations. We hope we can continue to celebrate with our local community again next year with your help and support.

**Rite of Consecration of the Altar (2):** The Mass of dedication begins with the blessing and sprinkling of holy water (blessed using a special prayer that brings out the significance of the dedication of the altar). The people are sprinkled as a reminder of their baptism when they were cleansed and became temples of the Holy Spirit. The new altar is sprinkled with the holy water as a sign of cleansing from all secular purposes or associations. This rite follows from the rite of consecration of the altar of burnt offering in the Book of Exodus. There the altar was sprinkled with the blood of the sacrifice to make it holy. To consecrate our altar for the unbloody sacrifice of the Mass we sprinkle the altar with the specially blessed water.
