The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the living sign of God's immense love for us.

Feast of Corpus Christi: 11th June. On this day the Church honours in a special way the mystery of the Body and Blood of Christ present for us in the Holy Eucharist. After the 10.45am Mass that day there will be Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, and weather permitting a short procession of the Blessed Sacrament around the grounds. The Church asks parishes to host such processions as a public witness to our faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Host.

Plan of Works for New Altar: The provision of the new altar for our church, in celebration of the 125th anniversary, comes in three main phases. Firstly, the altar had to be carefully deconstructed and removed from the derelict church in which it was previously housed, before being transported to the stonemasons. Secondly, the marble has to be re-polished and repairs undertaken (before we could get it out of the church some vandals broke in and caused significant damage). Thirdly, the altar has to be transported to Freckleton, supports built under the floor, and the altar installed in our church. This final phase should take place during August. Two very generous (anonymous) donations have been made towards this project already. The donor's generosity has covered the costs of the first phase of the work, which has now been paid off. I am extremely grateful to them. If you wish to make a contribution towards this legacy project for the future of our parish by providing new altar for our church, please mark an envelope "new altar" with your donation. These can be placed into the offertory plate or pushed through the presbytery letterbox. If you are on the gift aid scheme please put your envelope number on any offering towards the new altar.
