Mass Intentions: The parish has very nearly run out of intentions for the Mass. The Mass is the greatest prayer we have. It can be offered for the living or the dead, in thanksgiving or in petition. Offering of Mass is an expression of charity towards our neighbour. Any Mass intentions you have would be most gratefully received.

Aid to the Church in Need: The current leaflet, available in the porch, has details of the problems facing the Church in Chile.

Installation of the New Altar: the stonemasons will arrive on Monday 21st August to install the new altar. This should take them 4 days, with an extra day for contingency. We will need volunteers on Sunday 20th August to clear the sanctuary of its current fittings. There is a baptism after Mass that day, so we will meet to do this at 2pm. At the end of that week we will need a team of volunteers on the Saturday morning to clean the church ready for Sunday Mass.

Dedication of an Altar (4): After the relics have been installed in the altar the Bishop will pray a long prayer of dedication offering the altar to God. In the second book of chronicles we see King Solomon standing before the new altar of the temple in the presence of all the people with hands outstretched in prayer to dedicate that altar of old. What the bishop does in prayers echoes this decisive event in the history of Israel. This prayer calls to mind all the altars built in the Old Testament for the worship of almighty God, by Noah, Abraham, Moses and many others. It shows how these altars have all been fulfilled in the altar of the Cross on which Jesus died, and that our altar is a place where this one sacrifice of Jesus is renewed. This prayer offers the altar to God, asks God to make it a place of union with Him and calls down the Holy Spirit upon it to set it aside forever for the worship of God.

We are organising a parish outing to Stonyhurst (Jesuit) College in the Ribble Valley on the 22nd August. The tour will commence at 2pm and last about 90 minutes. Stonyhurst has its origins at St Omer in 1593, then at Bruges and Liege, producing a number of English martyrs, including Blessed William Harcourt SJ of Weeton. By the end of 18th century, following upheavals in France, it had relocated to Stonyhurst. The cost of the tour is £15 and will, hopefully, include the museum. If interested, there is a form in the porch for your name and contact details.
