Gift Aid: A Gift Aid tax reclaim will be submitted shortly to HMRC for 2023/24. Please notify Fr Millar at Holy Family or Carmel Dawson at St Annes if you are no longer a taxpayer or you paid insufficient tax during 2023/24 to cover the tax that will be reclaimed on all your donations given under Gift Aid to all charities during the tax year.
