**Gospel reflection for Sunday.**

How often do we hear people say, or we find ourselves saying something like this:

*"There's nothing I can do about this now, perhaps I should pray?"*

It's like the instinct to pray is a "last chance solution"! The gospel extract in Mass this Sunday reminds us that a life of prayer is intrinsic to Christian discipleship rather than a last chance response!

Indeed, in this extract it is the disciples themselves who ask the Lord for his guidance on how to pray. This is a hard lesson to learn for many of us. Prayer offered at anytime is valuable and helpful, but prayer as part of the fabric of life means that its part of a living relationship which acknowledges God as our saviour and that he's in control of our destinies, So let's take the sentiments and words of the Our Father into our hearts and lives, and help to bring this prayerful relationship into the heart of our lives.
