Diocesan Centenary Mass. Lancaster Cathedral. Saturday October 18th 11.30. The date of our Diocesan centenary Mass draws closer! These are the arrangements which the Bishop has worked out for the celebration of this Mass, which will include schools, civic dignitaries, most of the Bishops of England and Wales, the Papal Nuncio, and Cardinal Nicholls of Westminster.

The event will be "ticket only" because of the numbers across the Diocese and the maximum capacity of St Peter's Cathedral in Lancaster (450).

Each parish will be allocated two tickets for representatives to be in the congregation. It is the parish priest's responsibility to allocate them accordingly. That's two tickets for Holy Family and two tickets for St Anne's Westby. About mid September, in both communities, there will be a list to sign up for possible attendance at the Mass. If you are free to attend, and wish to be put forward, please sign your name and phone number on the list. After a closing date, all the names will then be put into a bag, and two names will be pulled out, and notified. If you are applying as a couple please sign your names together.

This is the fairest and best way forward under these restrictive circumstances. The successful applicants will be notified by phone.

We don't know yet when the tickets are due for distribution, but it will be in good time before October 18th. Whoever is successful in this bid will be representing our communities and their attendance is much appreciated.
