**The Sunday Word**

Who made you? God made me. Why did God make you? To  
know him, love him and serve him in this life, and live with  
him in glory for all eternity! To people of a certain age these  
questions and answers will still be etched deep in the  
memory (for those of more tender years they are the  
opening questions/answers from "The Catechism" taught in  
schools and parishes before Vatican II in the 1960's.) That  
second answer seems to fit with today's gospel reading  
about the Transfiguration of the Lord. Jesus was making for  
Jerusalem in time for Passover. He knew his passion and  
death would risk his followers would get the wrong  
message.

On the top of Mount Tabor in Israel the Lord took with him  
his three trusted disciples and shared with them a vision of  
his eternal glory, reenforced by the presence of Moses and  
Elijah. This action reminded them, and it reminds us too,  
that humanity was made for the glory of God. We're not  
made to be successful, or rich, or all powerful...but solely for  
the glory of God. May our daily lives reflect that message to  
all around us...we are made for God's glory!
