**Laetare Sunday...and Happy Mothering Sunday.**

Laetare (latin for “Rejoice”) marks the half way point through  
the austerity of Lent. There’s a brief respite from that  
austerity today...Vestments for Mass are Rose coloured not  
Violet and Music in Mass can be more adventurous. It is also  
called Mothering Sunday, not to celebrate those who are a  
mother to us, but in former days Catholics would return to  
the church of their baptism (their “Mother” church) to give  
thanks for the gift of faith in Christ Jesus. More recently it has  
become a celebration of those who are mothers to us. Both  
worthy of profound thanks.
