How do we recognise the presence of God? Do you think you've had a personal experience of the presence of God with you? What was it like? It can have many characteristics, but maybe one might surprise us all...that gentleness can be powerful. Last Thursday, August 6th, we had the wonderful feast of the Lord's Transfiguration. With Jesus appeared the figures of Elijah and Moses both appearing in eternal glory. Both in their life having had very different experiences of the presence of God. Moses experiences involving fire cloud and storm, and Elijah's including the gentle breeze. Very different! God will be present to his people in obvious ways like the Sacraments, but also in often gentle understated and remarkable ways that we are not expecting. Be prepared to experience God in gentleness!
