Scenarios like...“My daughter has got into a bad way with drugs and friends who don't respect her...what can I do?” “My dad has dementia so bad he doesn't know me any more...what can I do” “Our marriage is falling apart...what can I do”? Listen to the voice of Peter in today's gospel. The fisherman from Galilee, no great status other than his faith, came out with the definitive response to the Lord's question: “you are the Christ, the Son of God” When we each have Caesarea Philippi moments in life...don't walk away from Christ as if he's not there...turn to him...he is there...he's on every cross in life that we carry...talk to him and believe deeply in his anointed life.
